

## **Additional Guidelines for Port Moody Korean Presbyterian Church (9/29/21 version)**

*These guidelines are in addition to the "General Guidelines for User Groups at St. John's," and may be subject to change with new scientific research and/or new provincial and diocesan directions.*

- The congregation will enter and leave the building through the main entrance facing St. John's Street.
- Congregation members will not greet each other with handshakes or other touching.
- To increase ventilation, the windows in the building will be opened, weather permitting, and fans will be turned on.
- All attendees will be masked. Only the pastor will be unmasked when singing, preaching, or otherwise leading worship.
- All attendees from different households/bubbles will keep social distance of at least 2m/6ft; households/bubbles may sit together.
- Printed orders of service will not be used – instead, materials will be shown via projector.
- A donations collection box will not be passed around – it will be placed in one stationary location for people to drop offerings into.
- Upon leaving and closing up the building, higher touch areas in the church, hall, and washrooms will be sanitized.
